Vines have been cultivated in Burgundy since at least the 3rd century, largely due to the influence of the church and its monasteries. Popularised by the French Revolution, the Burgundy vineyards contain some of the most famous appellations in France. Chardonnay and Pinot-Noir wines from this area remain unsurpassed elsewhere. Chablis is synonymous with quality dry whites, while the Côte de Nuits is famous for its red Grands Crus. The Côte de Beaune features the star appellations of Meursault and Montrachet, not forgetting Pommard and volnay, while further south, the Côte Châlonaise and the Mâconais produce a fabulous range of sun-ripened wines. Closer to Lyon, popular Beaujolais made from gamay grapes enlivens social occasions the world over.

ALSACE

Over the centuries, and just like the countryside it winds its way across, the Alsace wine region has progressively increased and enhanced its own natural advantages. Its geographic situation between Germanic and Roman influences, tells its own story a culture dating from the Roman era, revitalized by Merovingians who consumed great quantities of "this stimulating wine that makes you happy". By the end of the first millennium, 160 Alsace villages were already growing vines and, by the Middle Ages, the wines of Alsace were among the among the most highly prized in all of Europe. Winegrowing in Alsace reached its zenith in the 16th century. This period of prosperity was brutally interrupted by the Thirty Years' War (1618-1648) which devastated the region. Pillaged, depopulated and ravaged by disease, all commercial activity declined dramatically.

RHONE VALLEY

Majestic, beautiful and magnificent, the Rhône river powers through the hilly escarpments of the North and dances along the pebbles of the broad Southern plain. From Vienne to the deltas of the Camargue, the Rhône carries a thousand fragrances and more than 25 grape varieties. North of valence, Syrah (Shiraz) reigns supreme over the red wines of Cote-Rôtie, Cornas and Hermitage, while Viognier in the whites is synonymous with the exceptional Condrieu. The South with its myriad of villages uses Grenache as the base for most wines, but also cultivates a whole host of Mediterranean grape varieties. Gorged with sunshine, the wines of the Rhône enjoy ripe fruity flavours and smooth mellow textures.
